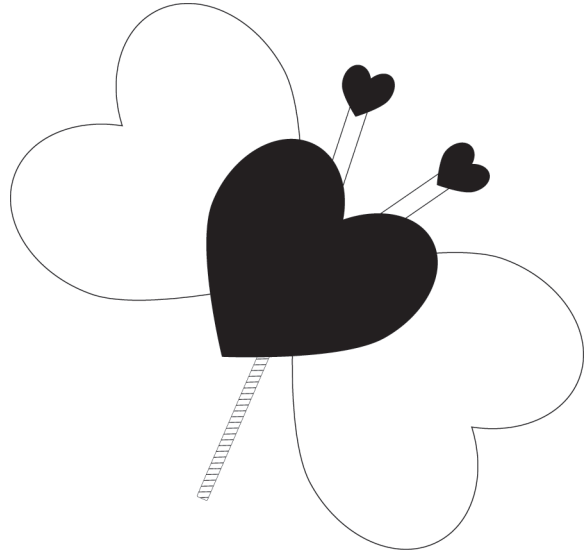


Instructions:

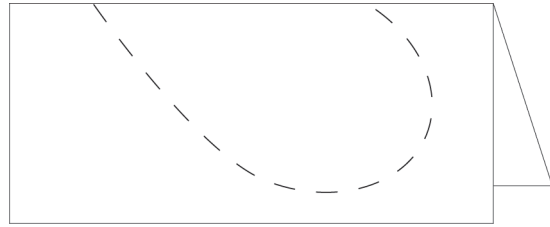
Materials:

1. (2) 4½" x 6" pieces of white construction paper
2. (1) 3" x 6" piece of red construction paper
3. Pipe Cleaner
4. Scissors and Paste
5. Pencils



Steps:

1. Fold one 4½" x 6" piece of white construction paper in half, lengthwise. Draw on half a heart and cut out.

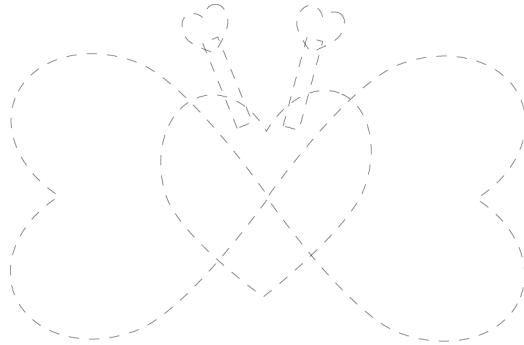


2. Fold the other piece of 4½" x 6" white construction paper, trace half of the other heart and cut out. This will make two hearts of the same size.

3. From scraps, cut out a red heart for body and two little hearts for the top of the feelers.

4. Cut two narrow white pieces for feelers.

5. Paste or glue the pieces together.



6. Attach a pipe cleaner to the underside of the butterfly. Then the butterfly can be made to appear to fly on bulletin boards, chairs, etc.
